Guidelines & Criteria

The Sun Foundation, in collaboration with the Illinois Arts Council, a state agency, and the National Endowment for the Arts, awards Community Art Access Grants each year, subject to grant approval. The program is funded by a grant of \$10,000 from the Illinois Arts Council funded by the National Endowment for the Arts and local matching funds.

Enclosed you will find a grant application for the Sun Foundation 2024 Community Arts Access Grants program. We invite you to submit an application for granting funds for either virtual, remote or in person arts programing following the prescribed COVID-19 health protocol of your health department Non-profit groups and organizations and individual artists with public projects in Marshall, Bureau, Woodford and Stark counties are eligible for grants up to \$1,000.

APPLICATION GUIDELINES

Sun Foundation Community Arts Access Grants can be used for artist's fees, art supplies, artist's transportation and software to be used directly for the program/ project. **Artist fees are a top priority**.

Projects must be for non-profit groups, organizations, schools and individual artists with projects and programs that are presented from *February 1–August 31, 2024*.

Grant Exclusions

Grant funds cannot be used for artistic programs or functions where artists are not the primary focus. Grants cannot be used to support fundraising projects, benefits, receptions or other social functions.

Grant funds will not be awarded for capital expenditures, permanent equipment, funding for out of state touring, scholarships or deficit funding. All projects must have a public community service emphasis to be funded.

Application Submission

- When making more than one application, prioritize by placing a number in the indicated space at the top right hand corner of the application (page 3).
- Use the space provided in the grant application. Please be concise to assist grant readers.
- Attach digital copies of support material such as resumes or brochures for each application.

GRANT REVIEW

For grant approval, hiring Illinois artist/artists, community involvement, and reaching the under-served are all vitally important.

A 1 to 5 point system is applied to each grant, 5 being the highest point rating. If applications exceed available funds, grants with the highest rating and priority number will receive funding. Notifications will be sent by January 31, 2024.
